Attached for your information are the final fiscal year (FY) 2020 Public Water System Supervision (PWSS) Grant Allotments. The final amount available for funding the PWSS Grant Program is \$106,250,000. This includes \$7,000,000 to support activities addressing PFAS and other contaminants of emerging concern. The State and Tribal support formula allotments were calculated utilizing final FY2020 funding levels, and the funds have been directed to the Region's accounts.

Attached are the state-by-state allotments, and the total amount available to each Region for its tribal support program. For each allotment, the attachment includes the total amount, the funding for the general PWSS program, and the funding for PFAS and other contaminants of emerging concern.
