


### All Time Submission Summary

## Internet Explorer

- Microsoft no longer supports Internet Explorer (IE) on most Windows 10 platforms
  - IE will not be supported on Windows 11 at all

- RCRAInfo shows various errors if IE is used
  - "Can't access our site's manifests"
  - "We don't have permission to our EPA ID numbers"

- **Beginning October 1, 2021:** Any manifest that originates (signed by the generator) will be charged the fiscal years 2022 and 2023 user fee rate when submitted to the e-Manifest system by the receiving facility.
- Receiving facilities will see their first invoices reflecting the new rates starting in November 2021.

### Update on e-Manifest Third Rule

- The proposed rule considers regulatory amendments to manifest regulations for:
  - Hazardous waste export and import shipments;
  - Manifest-related reports for generators (Exception Reports) and receiving facilities (Discrepancy and Unmanifested Waste Reports); and
  - Other technical and conforming changes, e.g., for PCB regulations under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA).
- The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) received the proposed rule on August 13, 2021, for interagency review. OMB/interagency review typically extends ~90 days.
- Any changes made in response to interagency review will be documented in the docket for the rule.

### Electronic Manifest Virtual Public Meetings

- On October 27 and November 3, the e-Manifest program will host <u>virtual public</u> meetings to discuss how to increase the electronic manifest adoption rate.
- Purpose is to obtain individual attendee feedback on potential future options
  EPA could bring to the e-Manifest Advisory Board.
- These meetings are identical; you only need to register for one of the two.
