SUBJECT: Final Allotments for the FY2023 Public Water System Supervision (PWSS) State and Tribal Support Program Grants

Attached for your information are the final fiscal year (FY) 2023 Public Water System Supervision (PWSS) Grant Allotments. The final amount available for funding the PWSS Grant Program is \$121,500,000, an increase of \$8,500,000 from FY 2022. This includes \$12,000,000 to support activities addressing per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) and other contaminants of emerging concern. The State and Tribal support formula allotments were calculated utilizing final FY2023 funding levels, and the funds have been directed to the Regions' accounts.

Attached are the state-by-state allotments and the total amount available to each Region for its tribal support program. For each allotment, the attachment includes the total amount, the funding for the general PWSS program, and the funding for PFAS and other contaminants of emerging concern.

EPA is committed to a productive partnership with states, tribes, and territories to maximize the impact the funds have in addressing urgent water challenges facing communities. For decades, the PWSS program has been integral to the operations of the nation's public water systems. It will continue to support the implementation of health protection standards for drinking water systems that serve the public. Further, the program will play a key role in supporting the prioritization of the nation's water infrastructure improvements enacted through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, especially those in disadvantaged, rural and small communities.
